Integration, discrimination, and social participation remain central issues of our time. We must work together to break down barriers and create opportunities.

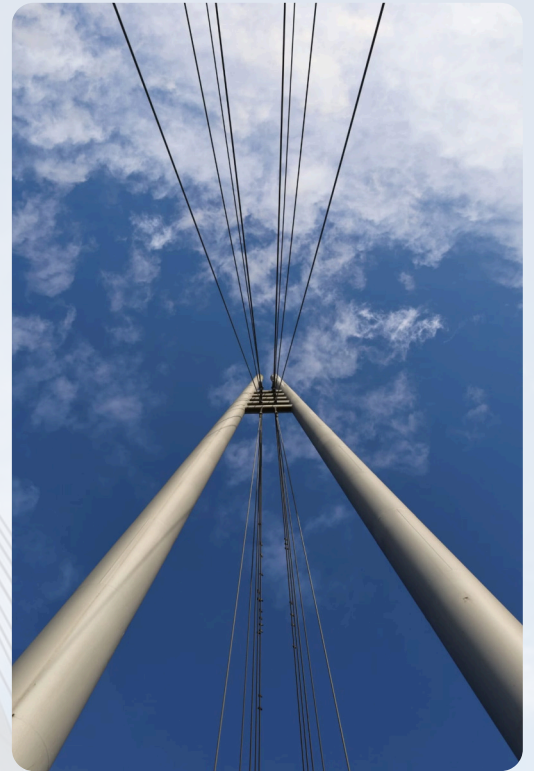
# 1. Strengthening Political Participation and Co-determination

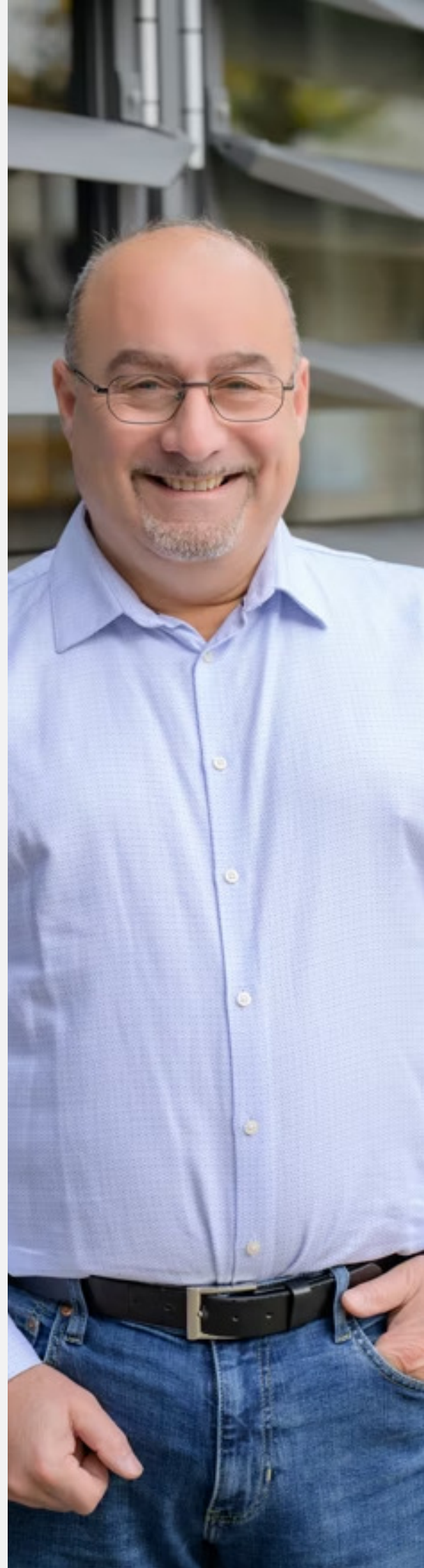
